The members of the Woman's Board raise critical resources for the Clubs through the annual Summer Ball and offer unique opportunities for Club members to experience the best of Chicago, with a particular focus on arts and culture, and support the pursuit of higher education for high achieving Club members.

The Woman's Board is strongly committed to taking a hands-on approach, and members enjoy having opportunities to visit and spend time at the Clubs.

## Share Chicago

Despite their proximity to downtown Chicago, many of our Club youth never have the opportunity to explore the city's greatest treasures. Funding of this program provides transportation, meals, and admission to many of Chicago's landmarks, including the Art Institute, the Mayor's Office, and the Skydeck at Willis Tower. Most recently, the Woman's Board has presented experiences in the restaurant and hospitality industries, allowing more discovery of the opportunities the city has to offer.

## College Scholarships

Members of the Woman's Board firmly believe that support of Chicago's youth should not end at high school graduation. Each year, the Board's Scholarship Committee awards four to six scholarships, with an additional one or two Ann Milligan Gray Scholarships awarded. To date, these scholarship programs have awarded more than 100 scholarships, totaling more than \$4.5 million in funding. They are continuing to expand this support to meet the ambitions and increasing needs of our hardworking and dedicated youth.

## The Summer Ball

The first Summer Ball was hosted at the Post and Paddock Clubhouse at Arlington Race Track over 75 years ago. Welcoming 500 guest, including Chicago's most notable players in business and philanthropy, the event was a huge success and set the standard for other fundraising galas across the city.

We are excited to host the 76th Annual Summer Ball and continue to honor the generations of Woman's Board members who have made an impact Chicago's youth.
